

Qualifying Under Free and Reduced Lunch Program/USDA Guidelines

Effective from July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2027

Applicants will be required to provide a copy of their most recent 1040 signed income tax return from 2025. **The student applying must be listed as a dependent on income tax return.**

For each additional family member, add	\$10,508.00

Reminder: Total income before taxes, social security, health benefits, union dues or other deductions must be reported. Income guidelines provided by USDA.gov.

You may also be eligible if a student is a current recipient of **(CURRENT letter of eligibility must be provided):**

- Medicaid
- SNAP
- TANF

Or currently in:

- Nassau Families in Transition (FIT)/ McKenny Vento Act Program
- Foster care
